

Medicare Part C Plan Identification Numbers to Be Available Through EDI and TexMedConnect

Effective May 28, 2011, the TMHP Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) will be updated to include information that will help providers that are filing claims for clients who have dual Medicare Part C and Medicaid eligibility.

When providers make client eligibility inquiries through EDI, the response will include the Medicare Part C Plan Identification number for clients who are eligible for Medicare Part C and enrolled with a Medicare Advantage Plan (MAP) on the date of inquiry.

Providers will need to compare the client's Medicare Part C Contract Number and Plan ID against the list of contracted MAPs located in the EDI section of this website to determine whether a client is enrolled in a MAP that is contracted with the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC). Revised EDI companion guides including these changes will be available in the EDI section of this website on May 28, 2011.

Effective June 25, 2011, providers that use TexMedConnect will be able to see Medicare Part C Plan Identification numbers for their clients on the Eligibility Verification screen.
