

Correction to “Wound Care Management Services to Be a Benefit of the CSHCN Services Program”

Information posted April 13, 2012

This is a correction to an article titled, “[Wound Care Management Services Benefit to Change for the CSHCN Services Program](#),” which was published on this website on March 16, 2012.

The article should have included physician assistants (PAs) as valid providers for wound debridement (procedure codes 97597 and 97598) and surgical wound debridement (procedure codes 11000, 11001, and 11042).

The article incorrectly indicated that surgical wound debridement (procedure codes 11043 and 11044) may be submitted for reimbursement by advanced practice registered nurse (APRN) providers. These services are not reimbursed to APRN providers.

The following are the corrected statements in the article:

Wound debridement procedure codes 97597 and 97598 may be submitted for reimbursement by physician, APRN, PA, dentist, podiatrist, or physical therapy providers in the office, inpatient hospital, and outpatient hospital settings.

Surgical wound debridement (procedure codes 11000, 11001, and 11042) may be submitted for reimbursement by physician, APRN, PA, and podiatrist providers who are licensed by the state of Texas to perform these procedures.

Surgical wound debridement procedure codes 11043 and 11044 may be submitted for reimbursement by physician, dentist, or podiatrist providers.
