

# **Revised Enrollment Applications to Be Available December 17, 2012**

Information posted December 7, 2012

On or after December 17, 2012, the online Provider Enrollment on the Portal (PEP) and the following paper provider enrollment applications will be updated:

- Texas Medicaid Provider Enrollment Application version XXII
- Texas Health Steps (THSteps) Provider Enrollment Application version XVII
- Texas Health Steps (THSteps) Dental Provider Enrollment Application version XIX
- CSHCN Services Program Provider Enrollment Application version XVII
- CSHCN Services Program Expedited Enrollment Application version II
- Medical Transportation Program Lodging Provider Enrollment Application version VII
- Medical Transportation Program Meals Provider Enrollment Application version VI

The following changes have been made to PEP and the paper enrollment applications as applicable:

- Affordable Care Act of 2010 (ACA) updates made to the PIF-1, PIF-2, PIF-Dental, and the Disclosure of Ownership and Control Interest Statement
- The addition of the Licensed Midwife (LM) provider type checkbox
- The addition of the Physician's Letter of Agreement form for LMs and certified nurse midwives (CNMs)
- HHSC Provider Agreement updated
- Texas Women's Health Program (TWHP) updates including the new certification form

## **New Application for Ordering- and Referring-Only Providers**

A new application has been created for ordering- and referring-only provider enrollment. Beginning January 1, 2013, ordering- and referring-only providers can enroll in Texas Medicaid online using PEP or the paper Texas Medicaid Provider Enrollment Application Ordering and Referring Providers Only which will be available for download from this website.

## **Transition Period**

Previous versions of the paper provider enrollment application will no longer be accepted on or after January 1, 2013. The previous versions of the applications may be accepted during the month of December if the provider is not required to be ACA compliant immediately.
