

Update to “Temporary Moratorium Imposed on Home Health Agency and Ground Ambulance Providers in Certain Counties of Texas”

This is an update to an article titled “Temporary Moratorium Imposed on Home Health Agency and Ground Ambulance Providers in Certain Counties of Texas,” which was published to this website on January 30, 2014.

Effective immediately, the temporary enrollment moratorium has been lifted for licensed home health agencies located in counties originally affected by the moratorium, and that only provide services to clients who are 20 years of age and younger through the Comprehensive Care Program (CCP). These providers can now enroll in Texas Medicaid or the Children with Special Health Care Needs (CSHCN) Services Program.

The counties originally affected by the moratorium are:

- Brazoria
- Chambers
- Collin
- Dallas
- Denton

- Waller

Licensed and certified home health agencies in these affected counties continue to be temporarily prevented from enrolling in Texas Medicaid or the CSHCN Services Program, until Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) lifts the moratorium.
