

DSHS Division for Family and Community Health Seeking Input from Any Texas Family That Has a Child With Special Health Care Needs

As part of a statewide needs assessment, the Division for Family and Community Health at the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) is currently surveying Texas families that have children with special health care needs. DSHS will use the results of the survey to guide their priorities and provide programs for the next five years aimed at helping to improve the health of Texas families and the health and safety of Texas communities.
