

New ICD-10 Benefit Change Articles Posted October 10, 2014, for the CSHCN Services Program: Refer to the TMHP ICD-10 Benefit Updates Web Page for Details

Information posted October 10, 2014

Note: *This article applies to claims submitted to TMHP for processing. For claims processed by a Medicaid managed care organization (MCO), providers must refer to the MCO for information about benefits, limitations, and reimbursement.*

Effective for dates of service on or after October 1, 2015, TMHP will implement the *International Classification of Diseases, Tenth Revision, Clinical Modification (ICD-10-CM)* diagnosis coding changes as directed by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

In preparation for the implementation of the ICD-10-CM diagnosis code changes, TMHP, the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC), and the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) are updating medical policies to include proposed ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes that will be effective for dates of service on or after October 1, 2015.

Important: At this time, the list or lists in this article that identify the ICD-10-CM replacements for specific *International Classification of Diseases, Ninth Revision, Clinical Modification (ICD-9-CM)* diagnosis codes may not be all-inclusive. As medical policies continue to update, the list or lists of ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes for specific benefits are subject to change. Providers will be notified if lists change.
