

# Benefit Changes for CSHCN Ambulatory Blood Pressure Monitoring and Devices Effective July 1, 2015

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Effective for dates of service on or after July 1, 2015, benefit criteria will change for Ambulatory Blood Pressure Monitoring and Devices for the Children with Special Health Care Needs (CSHCN) Services Program.

The following procedure codes will no longer be diagnosis restricted:

Procedure Codes			
93784	93786	93788	93790

The following conditions will apply to the above procedure codes:

- White coat hypertension
- Resistant hypertension
- Evaluation of hypotensive symptoms as a response to hypertension medications
- Nocturnal angina
- Episodic hypertension
- Evaluation of syncope

Ambulatory blood pressure monitoring over two services may be considered when documentation of medical necessity is submitted with the claim.
