

PEP, OPL, and OFL Enhancements

Information posted December 18, 2015

Beginning December 18, 2015, TMHP will revise Provider Enrollment on the Portal (PEP), Online Provider Lookup (OPL), and Online Fee Lookup (OFL) to include updating the terms “multispecialty clinic” and “physician group (MDs only and multispecialty)” to “clinic/group practice” in PEP, OPL, and OFL. This is due to the Medicare change in process for enrolling multi-specialty and single-specialty physicians groups under the specialty called “clinic/group practice.”

PEP Enhancements

PEP is used by providers to enroll in state health-care programs. With the scheduled enhancements, the “Multi-Specialty Group” checkbox on the Provider Type Identification page for Texas Medicaid enrollments in PEP will update to reflect “Clinic/Group Practice.” The “Physician group (MDs only and multispecialty)” checkbox on the Provider Type Identification page for Children with Special Health Care Needs (CSHCN) Services Program enrollments in PEP will be updated to reflect “Clinic/Group Practice.”

“Multispecialty Clinic” in the Provider Specialty dropdown on the Provider Specialty/Taxonomy page for all enrollments in PEP will be updated to reflect “Clinic/Group Practice.”
