

November 2018 NDC-to-HCPCS Crosswalk Now Available for Clinician-Administered Drug Processing

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The monthly [Texas National Drug Codes \(NDC\) to Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System \(HCPCS\) Crosswalk](#) is now available for clinician-administered drug (CAD) processing.

The NDC-to-HCPCS Crosswalk identifies relationships between National Drug Codes and Medicaid-payable Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System codes. The Health and Human Services Commission publishes the crosswalk monthly, based on quarterly additions to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' list of rebate-eligible drugs and new drugs added monthly to the First Databank pricing compendia. The crosswalk is intended to assist providers with accurate claims submission.
