

August 2019 NDC-to-HCPCS Crosswalk Now Available

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The August 2019 [Texas National Drug Codes \(NDC\) to Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System \(HCPCS\) Crosswalk](#) is now available for clinician-administered drug (CAD) processing.

The NDC-to-HCPCS Crosswalk identifies relationships between National Drug Codes and Medicaid reimbursable Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System codes. The Texas Health and Human Services Commission publishes the crosswalk, based on quarterly additions to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services list of rebate-eligible drugs and new drugs that are added monthly to the First Databank pricing compendia. The crosswalk is intended to assist providers with accurate claims submission.

The next crosswalk will be available in October. Beginning in October, the Texas Vendor Drug Program (VDP) will publish the crosswalk on a quarterly basis, with future crosswalks available in January, April, and July.
