5. Compliance Updates and Reminders

- PSOs should note that they are a program provider or FMSA that has been approved to use an EVV proprietary system and are still required to comply with all policies applicable to program providers or FMSAs.
- PSOs are responsible for ensuring their Proprietary Systems are complying with the current Business Rules as noted on the PSO Certification Form that is signed by the Signature Authority. Provider PSOs and FMSA PSOs are responsible for required EVV Training as listed in EVV Training policy (Section 4200 of the EVV Policy Handbook)

Top 10 Reasons for Rejections (for all PSOs for April 2025)

Ex00031C	The Member's Payer on the EVV visit does not match our records for this Member.	43.65%
	Member on the EVV visit is not authorized for this Provider Number on this visit date in our records.	17.34%
Ex00057C3	The Member on the EVV visit is not authorized for this service group/service code on this visit date in our records.	15.45%
Ex00034C2	The Member Medicaid ID on the EVV visit does not have active Medicaid eligibility for the visit date.	10.37%
Ex00043C	The plan code on the visit is not associated with the Member's Payer.	9.01%
Ex0007C1	The Provider Number on the EVV visit is not associated with this provider NPI/API for the Visit Date.	1.36%
Ex0002C	Provider NPI cannot be validated as active for the visit date.	1.29%
Ex00034C1	The Member Medicaid ID on the EVV visit is not found in our records.	0.71%
Ex00028B	CDS Employer EVV ID is required when service is CDS service.	0.62%

- The impacted PSOs have been notified and are working with TMHP to correct the issues to remain in compliance with BRs and EVV policy.
- Program providers and FMSAs who verify and submit visits to the EVV Aggregator that reject, can cause decrease in their EVV usage score possibly causing them to drop below the 80% threshold for compliance with EVV Usage.

1. EVV Compliance Questions:



Question: How do we get in compliance with EVV? And what are the likely reasons why an agency will not be in compliance? *Answer:*

PSOs are subject to EVV Compliance Reviews, conducted by the payers (HHSC and managed care organizations). PSOs must:

- 1. Meet the EVV Usage Score requirement of at least 80% each state fiscal year quarter. Run your EVV Usage Report in the EVV Portal to check your EVV Usage Score and take action if the score is below 80%.
- 2. Ensure service providers use a valid phone type when clocking in and out with the landline method.
- 3. Ensure service providers use an alternative device to clock in and clock out for the allowable percentage of visits per the <u>Alternative Device Reduction Schedule</u> for your NPI/API (and Provider Number if HHSC is your payer) each state fiscal year quarter, starting Sept. 1, 2025.
- 4. Ensure your EVV proprietary system complies with:
 - HHSC policy for EVV proprietary systems.
 - HHSC EVV Business Rules for Proprietary Systems.
 - <u>1 TAC, Part 15, Chapter 354, Subchapter O, Electronic Visit Verification.</u>
 - <u>Texas Government Code Chapter 532, Subchapter F, Electronic Visit Verification</u> <u>System.</u>

The PSO and EVV proprietary system may be subject to periodic verification, system testing and auditing as specified by TMHP. TMHP may not allow the use of an EVV proprietary system if the EVV proprietary system vendor is out of compliance with any EVV requirements. Refer to <u>5080 Proprietary System Operator</u> <u>Compliance</u> in the EVV Policy Handbook for more information.

Question: Can you please restate the monitoring dates for compliance? *Answer:* Payers conduct EVV Usage Reviews for program providers, FMSAs, and CDS Employers on a quarterly basis. The review period schedule for EVV Usage Reviews is in Section 11010, EVV Usage Reviews, of the EVV Policy Handbook. Payers conduct EVV Landline Phone Verification Reviews at the payer's discretion. The review period schedule for EVV Usage Reviews is in Section 11020, EVV Landline Phone Verification Reviews, of



the EVV Policy Handbook.

Question: What happens if an agency stays not compliant with the token usage? *Answer:* A program provider may have their contract terminated if they continue to fail to meet the standards (this information was provided during the meeting). The full EVV policies for alternative devices will be published on the HHSC EVV website in an upcoming standalone policy document.

2. Visit Maintenance & Auto-Verification Questions:

Question: Is there a way to get the statewide average of auto verified EVV visits by PS Vendor? Answer: This would be considered an Open Records Request under the Texas Public Information Act. 3. EVV System & Operations Questions:

Question: Who do we email to request our current transaction scores? *Answer:* Please email EVV Operations at evv@hhs.texas.gov.

Question: How is it going to work for the areas that still do not have internet or have a lot of issues with internet signal, etc.?

Answer: Effective March 12, 2025, each EVV Proprietary System's mobile method must be able to capture clock in and clock out when internet connection or cellular data is not available. When the Service Provider is in an area without internet connection or in an area with poor internet signal, the Service Provider can use the mobile method to clock in



and clock out.

Question: What is CAP? *Answer:* Corrective Action Plan.

4. EVV Reason Codes Questions:

Question: Is there any Reason code update? *Answer:* The <u>EVV Reason Codes</u> that were effective Aug. 1, 2023 are the current EVV Reason Codes.

5. Rejection Code and Error Questions:

Question: Is there a way we can get an Edit Code report like this filtered just for our agency? As a follow up, I think TMHP should provide this to remove bias. *Answer:* You may visit the EVV Portal to conduct a Search within the 'Visit History Search' tab. There are various search criteria fields you can fill out to produce results. The Visit Date Range (Begin Date and End Date) is required to complete the search. This search will populate detailed results such as if the EVV visit is accepted/rejected, the edit code and description, payer, etc. For more information on how to navigate the EVV Portal, please visit the TMHP LMS to review the published EVV Portal job aids.

Question: I am merely stating that MCO's are NOT presenting us with current auths. We are having to enter visits manually due to us not having the Auths. Our scores are going to plummet. How are we supposed to defend ourselves in this situation? *Answer:* Per <u>11000, EVV Compliance Reviews | Texas Health and Human Services</u>, Before enforcing action, payers must do their due diligence and make sure failure to meet and maintain the compliance score was not because of:

- Payer errors such as:
 - \circ Late authorizations
 - Missing or incorrect HCPCS, Modifiers, Service Group or Service Codes provided by the payer
- A system outage, defect or issue related to the EVV Aggregator, EVV Portal or an EVV Vendor System



Natural disasters

If you determine that your usage score is below 80% because the MCO failed to provide the authorization timely or the authorization provided was incorrect, please email <u>evv@hhs.texas.gov</u>.

Question: If there is a retro change to a service code. Are we affected by it? *Answer:* If there's a retroactive change to a service code, it can affect providers. Retroactive changes can impact billing, reporting, and compliance with regulations.
